

CHOOSING & USING

DEET Concentration

Simple, the higher the concentration... the longer it lasts. But be careful, if it's a very low percentage (<10%) it won't last very long at all

Application

It's believed that a mosquito can find an exposed/ unprotected area of skin the size of a small coin and attack!

You must make sure that when applying any repellent you cover all exposed skin completely

Wear and Tear

Be mindful if you're outdoors and working up a sweat, the repellent could be getting washed or rubbed off

Be sure to keep your repellent coverage topped up!

Mosquito saliva has some of the same ingredients as rat poison

After biting a mosquito leaves a dollop of saliva. It's our natural immune response that results in that annoying itching

Mosquitoes bite both day and night



The Aedes species of Mosquito bite during the day. Others, like Culex, start biting at dusk and continue a few hours into dark
